

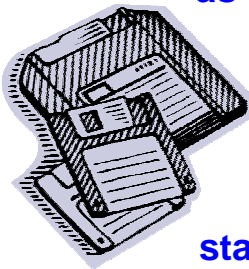
## Student Leadership Project Spring 2004

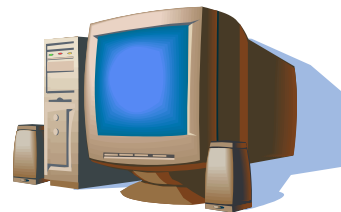
